Prerequisites for the Exhibition

01

A six-year plan for the development of the road network has been approved – to bring 85% of federal highways and backbone roads up to regulatory standards.

03

A preferential leasing program for utility and road construction equipment has been launched, developed by the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation and the state company DOM.RF: \$\pm\$50 billion in funding until 2030.

Conclusion:

Infrastructure development plans require the provision of necessary construction resources, special-purpose machinery, and transportation. A regular and high-quality dialogue is needed between manufacturers and both state and private customers.

Active Design and Survey Works (DSWs) are being carried out, which will result in major infrastructure projects across the Russian Federation

04

Promising infrastructure projects:

Northern Latitudinal Railway, more than 50 high-speed bypass roads around major cities, and the "Dry Port Yekaterinburg" transport and logistics hub.








Competition Objective:

The National Operators' Competition places a strong focus on attracting young professionals into the sector. Special emphasis is placed on the Youth Track, which aims to unlock the potential of the next generation of operators.

In 2024, the Competition acquired international status, received a Best BRICS Solutions Award, and was recognized among the best practices in workforce development and skills advancement.

Operator teams from leading road construction companies — using equipment from both domestic and international manufacturers — will compete for the title of the best in the profession.

In 2025, the competition will welcome participants from top road construction companies in the Russian Federation, Republic of Belarus, People's Republic of China, Republic of Kazakhstan, Republic of Türkiye, and other countries






